

## Our Obstacles, Our Solutions

#### Universal obstacles? Two categories:

#### **Systemic**

Lack of personnel (difficulties hiring or little funding), time, or other resources Contract obligations time consuming (e.g. DMMM, meetings, reporting) Finance process slow, slows everything

#### Data Product Development and Management

Communication & expectations: lack of feedback Iterative development needs limits, a little less iteration Updates? Difficult to implement, maintain, complex

#### Some proposed solutions?

- Use contractors to fill data professional roles
- Reduce contract obligations fewer meetings, less reporting (e.g. DMMM)
- Develop internal systems for data management/governance to, for example, impose rules for development processes including acceptance, testing, buy-in process
